- Arrival** After checking-in at the *Front Desk*, please bring your music CD to the *Audio Station* by the main stage. Please take the time (even if you are late) to make sure you are checked-off on the audio performer list, and give us your CD—otherwise we won't know if you are here, and your music will not be ready when you perform.
- CD Media** **PLEASE: CDs only. No Cell-phones, Laptops, or MP3 players. Use standard CD-Rs (plain, not colored) or commercial CDs. MP3s ok only if they are on a finalized CD.**
- One CD ONLY per dancer or group.** Put *all* the music tracks for your routine on the CD *in sequence*. Separate tracks (1, 2, 3, etc.) are preferred rather than one long compiled track. Include all necessary pauses. *Do not expect us to play out-of-sequence track cues or more than one CD per act.* Set-up your track sequence, burn it to a CD-R, and check that it works on a standard player. Be prepared. *This is not a rehearsed showcase. We've never seen your dance or heard your CD before now.*
- Put your CD in a proper CD envelope or case.** Dirty and scratched CDs don't play correctly. *Keep them clean.*
- A safety-copy of your dance-routine music CD is highly recommended. S___ happens.**
- Audio Format** Please use .WAV or .AIFF audio-file formats. MP3s ok only on finalized CDs.
- CD Lables** Clearly print in dark ink on *The CD* and *The Case*:
— Your dance/troupe name
— Dance time (Sunday @ --)
—Total length of music on CD
- Instructions:** ***Brief introduction by M.C.*** (print on an index card for M.C.)
— Name (Include a phonetic spelling . . . otherwise, we guess)
— Where you are from?
— A very brief introduction
- Simple stage directions***
Ex: "start music after dancer on stage," "fade music as troupe leaves stage."
- Leaving** Remember to pick up your CD before you leave the event! CDs will be put in the RETURN box at the Audio Station after you perform. We often have abandoned CDs at day's end. Don't forget yours!
